**SUBJECT: SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES STRATEGIC GRANT**

**RECOMMENDATION.** It is respectfully recommended that the Commission receive and file this staff report.

**DISCUSSION.** This report is to update the Commission with regard to the joint efforts of SLOCOG and LAFCO in implementing the Sustainable Communities Strategic Grant for developing a County-wide Infrastructure Inventory.

The San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG) was awarded a Grant by the Strategic Growth Council in late summer 2011. The State approved the Contract and Scope of Work in October 2011. Since that time a joint effort by LAFCO and SLOCOG has been ongoing to compile a list of existing documents prepared by various agencies to assist in the analysis of identifying important infrastructure on a County-wide basis. When finished, the list will consolidate the available reports, plans, and general plan elements as a reference document that relates to the six sectors of infrastructure being considered. The six sectors of infrastructure under study are:

- transportation,
- water (which includes wastewater and stormwater),
- energy
- telecommunication
- open space
- social & cultural

The infrastructure inventory will consolidate an up-to-date information base significant capital infrastructure projects, either planned or underway, in San Luis Obispo County. Each section will provide a snapshot of current infrastructure assets in the region and provides an overview of the sector, followed by a table of significant projects and associated information. Key issues and stakeholders will also be identified. The information for these sectors will be obtained by working with the various agencies and organizations with the goal of developing GIS layer sets of data that can be useful by all GIS users.
