Please find attached comments regarding the Cambria Community Service District (CCSD) recent DEIR on the Water Master Plan. It should be noted that your Initial Study Review Checklist review does not adequately address the CEQA requirements mandated by law. Given the complex water issues facing our community and the fact that nearly all the CCSD area of influence is located in state protected ESHA and that the watersheds surrounding Cambria have an abundance of listed species the check list provided in the initial study seems peculiarly odd since it shows no impacts of any kind will be caused by the CCSD's influence on our community.

The comments provided may help you and your staff further consider impacts that the current CCSD administration is placing on the environment.

In closing, we would like you to consider taking a wider view on your checklist analysis and perhaps consider that the narrow focus you have chosen could be broadened to include a more in-depth point of view of our coastal ESHA environs.
